MINUTES OF THE 47TH ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

Date: 30.08.2023

Venue: Conference Hall

Time: 10.00 A.M.

The 47th Academic Council meeting of the college was held on 30.08.2023 in Conference Hall at 10.00 a.m. The meeting started with the prayer said by Dr. P. Stella, HoD, Department of B.B.A.

Rev. Fr. Dr. S. Mariadoss, S.J., Principal & Chairman welcomed all the members of the Academic Council. Mr. Rajagopal, Mr. Thomas A. Antony (Industry), Rev. Fr. Dr. S. Arul Ravi, Vice Principal, Dr. M. Karmegam, HoD, Dept. of Folklore, Dr. G. Peter Michael Raj, HoD, Dept. of Physical Education, were unable to attend the meeting due to various reasons.

Fr. Principal, in his introductory note, shared the following: the 17 Sustainable Development Goals or Global Goals established by the United Nations in September 2015 are a collection of seventeen interlinked objectives designed to serve as a "shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future."

All the SDGs are grouped around five major themes: i) People, ii) Planet, iii) Prosperity, iv) Peace and V) Partnerships. Among the 17 SDGs, the 4th SDG speaks of Quality Education. The full title of SDG 4 is "Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all". Drawing many useful lessons from the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), it emphasizes equity and quality of education in a life-long learning approach.

Goal 4

- Aims to make education a contributing factor in making the world more secure, sustainable and interdependent.
- Addresses the areas of ensuring free, equitable and quality primary and secondary education leading to relevant and effective learning outcomes.
- Ensures access to quality early childhood development, care and pre-primary education.
- Provides equal access for all women and men to affordable and quality technical, vocational and tertiary education, including university.
- Increases the number of youth and adults who have relevant skills, including technical and vocational skills for employment, decent jobs and entrepreneurship.
- Eliminates gender disparities in education.

- Makes all learners acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development.
- Builds and upgrades facilities to provide safe, non-violent, inclusive and effective learning environments for all substantial expansion of the number of scholarships available to developing countries.

ECC / VALUE ADDED COURSE / ADD ON COURSE

Based on the recommendations of Planning and Evaluation Committee meeting held on 19.07.2023 and Curriculum Development Cell meeting held on 07.08.2023, the following resolutions were taken:

UG

- Completion of one Add- on Course, one Value Added course and one Extra Credit Course is compulsory for all the UG Students.
- Two Credits will be given for each Course.
- Students will complete these courses in the following order:
 - I UG – Add on Course (Programme Specific / Open to all)
 - II UG – Value Added Course (Programme Specific)
 - III UG – Extra Credit Course (Programme Specific / Open to all)
- Besides the above mentioned three compulsory courses, students are free to learn three more Extra Credit courses in different semesters. A student can study maximum of six courses during the entire UG Programme. Marks and credits obtained in Add-on, Value Added and ECC will be printed in consolidated mark statement separately.

PG

- Completion of one Value Added course and one Extra Credit Course is compulsory for all the PG Students.
- Three Credits will be given for each Course.
- Students will complete these courses in the following order:
 - I PG – Value Added Course
 - II PG – ECC
- Besides the above mentioned two compulsory courses, students are free to learn two more Extra Credit Courses in different semesters. A student can study a maximum of four courses during the entire PG Programme. Marks and credits obtained in Value Added and ECC will be printed in consolidated mark statement separately.

Fr. Principal informed that all the staff members are encouraged to create E- Content to offer Value Added and Add-on courses online. A course must consist of minimum of 30 hours of video lessons. Detailed guidelines for the preparation of E-Content will be evolved by the college shortly. All faculty members are asked to submit at least one E-Content on or before 30.09.2023.
