Minutes of the Board of Studies Meeting of the Department of Foundation Courses held on 07.02.2019

The meeting of the Board of Studies of the Department of Foundation Courses was held on 7th February 2019 at 10 am in the Conference Hall. The floor was led into prayer by Rev. Dr. L. John Peter Arulanandam S.J., Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J. Rector and Head of the Department of Foundation Courses welcomed the members especially Dr. Beulah Shekar, University Nominee and Mr.Arthur Kumar, Advocate, our Alumni. He also registered the absence request of Rev. Dr. Xavier Terence and Rev. Fr. Lawrence David. In his introductory note, Rev.Fr. Rector stressed the importance of Foundation Courses and stated their impacts on

Dr.S.P.Victor, Coordinator of Foundation Courses (Shift I), explained the existing courses offered by the Department of Foundation courses, namely:

- 1. Sem I VE 18UVE11 Religion / Ethics
- 2. Sem I SBE I 18USB11 Life Skills
- Sem II SBE 2 18USB21 Religion II / Employability Skills
- 4. Sem III SBE 4 18USB31 Human Rights and Social Analysis

He also said that the existing course materials were in Tamil and by the direction of the M.S. University, the examinations were conducted in English from this academic year 2018-19.

Rev.Dr.S.Mariadoss, S.J. felt that in the existing pattern, catholic students are deprived of learning Employability skills. Dr.M.Baby Mariatra said catholic students also expressed the same.

Rev.Dr.V.Henry Jerome S.J., presented the following set of new courses to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20 and explained the rationale behind the introduction:

- Sem I VE 19UVE11 Religion / Ethics
- Sem I SBE 1 19USB11 Integrated Personality Development
- 3. Sem II SBE 2 19USB21 Life Issues and Coping Skill Development
- 4. Sem III SBE 4 19USB31 Human Rights and Social Analysis

With regard to the course on Religion, Dr. Beulah Shekar, suggested to elaborate the contents of the units by giving sub headings.

In respect of the course on Ethics, it is suggested to elaborate the contents of the units by giving sub headings. Dr. Beulah Shekar, suggested to include ethical aspects of Thirukural and about the evils of corruptions and plagiarism. Dr. M. Baby Mariatra suggested to include Gandhi's seven Deadly sins.

Regarding the course on Integrated Personality Development, Dr. J. Amalanathan suggested thanging the title of Unit III as Learning Coping Strategies instead of Academic Coping trategies. Rev. Fr. V. Henry Jerome, suggested moving IQ, EQ, SQ, MQ form Unit I to Unit V. Dr. Beulah Shekar, suggested to include Grooming in second unit and Leadership types in Unit

As far as the course on Life Issues and Coping Skill Development, Mr. Arthur Kumar suggested to include the aspects of caring elders in Unit II. Dr. Beulah Shekar, suggested to include Counseling as part of Unit III. Dr. J. Amalanathan suggested changing the title of Unit V as Overcoming Addiction instead of Addiction. Members suggested to include the remedies for the addiction in Unit V.

Regarding the course on Human Rights and Social Analysis, Dr. S. David Appadurai suggested to introduce the understanding of society, and the need of social analysis as the first unit. He also suggested to combining the Units IV and V on Human Rights and Redressal Mechanisms as a suggested to include Unit V titled "Human Rights Perspectives and Redressal Mechanisms". Dr. single unit under Unit V titled "Human Rights Perspectives and Redressal Mechanisms". Dr. Beulah Shekar, suggested to include Democracy and types of Governance as part of the World Breulah Shekar suggested to include Preample of the constitution as part of Indian trends today. She also suggested to include Preample of the constitution as part of Indian Inguistic diversity along with Cransgender issues. Dr. J. Amalanathan suggested to include linguistic diversity along with cultural and religious diversity. He also suggested changing "Indian resources and poverty" as "Indian economic inequality and poverty".

With these suggestions the syllabuses for the proposed courses were passed by the Board members. It is resolved to implement these courses from the academic year 2019-2020. It is further resolved that the examinations will be conducted in English with worksheet model.

Under any other matter, the proposal to change the nomenclature of the Department of Foundation Course came up for discussion. After the discussion, it is unanimously resolved to change the name of the Department from "Department of Foundation Course" to "Department of Human Excellence".

Rev. Dr. L. John Peter Arulanandam, S.J. suggested to have at least two permanent staff for the Department of Foundation Course.

The meeting of the Board of Studies of the Department of Human Excellence was held on 7th February 2020 at 11.30 am in the Conference Hall. The floor was led into prayer by Rev. Dr. Paul C. Jesuraja. Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J. Rector, and Head of the Department of Human T. Xavier Terrence and Mr.Arthur Kumar, Advocate, our Alumni. He also registered the the importance of the courses offered and outlined their logical order. He suggested to have the course on Environment Studies as part of the Department of Human Excellence in order to complete the logical sequence.

Dr.S.P.Victor, Coordinator of Department of Human Excellence (Shift I), presented the minutes of the meeting of the previous Board of Studies. The board accepted and passed the minutes.

The chairman of the board, Rev.Dr.V.Henry Jerome S.J, initiated the discussion on the evaluation of the current courses offered.

Regarding the course on Religion (19UVE11), Rev.Dr. T. Xavier Terrence felt that introducing canon to the UG students is a difficult task. Rev. Dr. Paul C. Jesuraja suggested to get permission from the university to conduct the examination for Religion bilingually, if it is not possible he suggested to set question paper with English and Tamil versions of each question. Rev. Fr. Vincent proposed open book test on Religion. Members felt that this can be experimented. Rev.Dr.V.Henry Jerome S.J suggested that the issues like same sex marriage, caste in religion, vocation discernment and religious harmony are to be included. Members suggested to include some of the religious and Biblical personalities like Solomon, David, Paul, Ruth etc. and Biblical values. Accordingly, a new book will be prepared for next year.

Members felt that syllabus for the course on Ethics (19UVE11) is sufficient and suggested to have a comprehensive material.

Regarding the course on Integrated Personality Development (19USB11), Dr. Balamurugan suggested to reduce number of topics so that all are discussed within the stipulated time. Dr. S. Anna Venus, suggested to incorporate communication and body language as part of self-knowledge or self management. Members suggested to remove the topic "Learning the Development process; Tools and skills" from unit V in order to reduce the load.

Regarding the course on Life Issues and Coping Skill Development (19USB21), Dr. Beulah Shekhar suggested to conduct common programmes by professional counselors on overcoming addiction. She also suggested to conduct capacity building programme for the staff. The student representative Mr.Narayan, II B.Sc, Computer Science, also felt that input sessions conducted by professionals will be more effective and useful.

In Human Rights and Social Analysis (19USB31), all agreed to the suggestion by Mr. Arthur Kumar to include 'IDP, Refugees and Migration' in the unit II.

Prof. Jothi Kumar, Assistant Professor of computer science (shift II) presented the minutes of the meeting of the previous Board of studies. The Board accepted and passed the minutes.

The chairman of the Board, Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J., initiated the discussion on the evaluation of the current subjects offered.

Regarding the subject Religion (19UVE11), Rev. Sr. Maggie suggested that in Unit IV, Introduction of Mariology, Mary as Prophetus, a prophet of liberation can be included.

Staff who handles Ethics, expressed that during this pandemic situation we don't have much interaction with the students and sharing aspect is missing.

Regarding the subject Ethics (19UVE11), members suggested to make the following changes.

- . In Unit I, the word Meaning can be added in the beginning.
- In Unit IV, Role of family in inculcating Ethical Principles, Diversity and Discrimination,
 Data privacy, Nepotism, Cyber wisdom can also be included.

Regarding the subject Integrated Personality Development (19USB11): There was a general feeling expressed by Rev. Dr. Henry Jerome S.J., Rev. Sr. Maggie and Mr. Robinson that Unit I and V overlap and so the Board decided to redo it. The following changes also were suggested and accepted by the Board members.

- In Unit I from "Becoming aware of strength till the last part of it can be removed
 and instead SWOT Analysis JOHARI Window Enhancing one's self image, self
 esteem and self confidence are to be included.
- In unit II, the board decided to remove "sharpening the intellect schooling the mindsocializing the individual - Grooming", and add 'Goal setting – personal vision and mission statements'.

- Unit III is to be modified into "Art of generative listening, learning and writing Note making – Presentation skills – Cyber knowledge".
- Rev. Sr. Maggie suggested to include "Qualities of a good leader" in Unit IV.
- In Unit V the last part "Enhancing one's self image.......... IQ, EQ,SQ,MQ" are to be removed and it can be included in Unit I.
- The units are rearranged according to the suggestion given by the Chair person. Unit III
 can be brought it as Unit V. Hence it is rearranged into I, II, IV, V, III (of the existing
 Syllabus).
- Rev. Dr. Henry Jerome S.J. modified the learning outcomes with regard to the subject Integrated Personality Development as follows:

The second outcome is to "Identify the means of enhancing self esteem"

The fifth outcome "Summarise different dimensions of personality" can be brought it to 6° outcome.

Regarding the subject Life Issues and Coping Skill Development (19USB21), the members expressed to make the following changes.

- Unit II

 Removal of 'Vs' and inclusion of coma, and 'interdependence' after 'overdependence'.
- Unit IV ⇒ complete change into "Conflict/Crisis Management Stress Management Emotional Management Team, Task and Resource Management.
- Unit V

 instead of Introduction to the stages of addiction, "Various stages of addiction" and to include 'Impact, prevention and Remedies' at the end.

Regarding the subject Human Rights and Social Analysis (19USB31), the following changes were suggested.

- Unit III

 Pluralism can be added at the end.
- Unit IV

 "Some contemporary issues" can be included at the end.

As decided earlier, from the next academic year onwards, Environmental Studies will be added to the Department of Human Excellence. No changes were suggested in the subject.

Sr. Maggie was made to the University but the nomination is not yet received from the University. Rev. Fr. Rector registered the absence request of the subject expert Mr. R. Robinson Silva. In his introductory note, Rev. Fr. Rector stressed the importance of the coursed offered by the Department of Human Excellence and outlined the impacts on the students.

Dr. S.P. Victor, Coordinator of Department of Human Excellence (Shift I) presented the minutes of the meeting of the previous Board of studies. The Board accepted and passed the minutes. Rev. Paul C Jesuraja requested to circulate the minutes to the members within one or two weeks after the meeting.

The chairman of the Board, Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J., initiated the discussion on the evaluation of the current courses offered. The following are the changes suggested to be incorporated in the next syllabus revision:

In the course on Religion (21UVE11)

- 1. Members suggested unitizing the syllabus into five units in order to maintain uniformity.
- 2. Chapter 8 can be made as Introduction to Mariology.
- 3. In chapter 9 Contemporary issues to be introduced instead of Youth and the Church.

In the course on Ethics (21UVE11)

- Title of unit IV to be modified as "Family Ethics and Social Ethics" instead of "Ethics in Family ad Social Ethics"
- In unit V the topics from Ethics and students' life till cyber wisdom are to be removed and Cyber ethics to be introduced

In the course on Integrated Personality Development (21USB11)

 Title of unit IV to be modified as "Dimensions of Personality Development" instead of "Integrated Personality Development"

- 2. Title of unit V to be modified as "Academic Learning Strategies" instead of "Learning coping strategies"
- In unit V, the topics "Art of generative listening, learning and writing" are to be removed as these skills are covered in the professional English course for all the I UG students.

In the course on Life Issues and Coping Skill Development (21USB21)

- Title of unit IV to be modified as "Coping Strategies" instead of "Coping Skill Development"
- 2. In unit V the topic Passion Vs Addiction is to be removed.

In the course on Human Rights and Social Analysis (21USB31)

- 1. Add one more course outcome as "Understand the contemporary global trends"
- In unit III add Federalism, Pluralism along with Secularism. Remove the topics from problems of the minority to women empowerment. Instead of Preamble of the Indian constitution, Introduction to Indian constitution to be included.
- 3. In unit IV remove Right to information act. The topic "Violence against woman" to be changed as "Violence against women and gender justice". Change LGBT as LGBTQ. Change "Currently pressing issues" as "Currently pressing issues such as problem of minorities".
- 4. In unit V add fundamental duties and Right to Information

In the course on Environmental Studies (21UES31)

 In unit II change "Global warming and its effect of productivity" as "Global warming and its effect on productivity"

In general it is suggested to add more recent reference books for all the subjects. The meeting came to an end with the vote of thanks by Rev. Dr. V. Henry Jerome S.J.
