The meeting commenced with a silent prayer .All the members of the committee were welcomed by the Principal Rev.Dr.S.Mariadoss,S.J. The previous year meeting minutes was read by Prof.J.Rexy who is one of the members of the Anti-ragging committee. All the committee members introduced themselves. After the self introduction, Principal listed out the preventive measures that have been practiced in the college. Principal specified that the college had received an undertaking regarding ragging from the student as well as the parents. He mentioned that the awareness regarding Anti ragging was insisted during the bridge course for the first year students, in the orientation programme for first year students and also during the student council election. Principal mentioned that the fresher's day will be conducted in the hostel and in the

beginning of the departmental association activity in every academic year to make students feel at home.

Principal mentioned that the awareness regarding anti-ragging is being implemented through the public address system, permanent board in the campus with the names and phone numbers of anti ragging committee and the students are encouraged to use suggestion box to express their suggestions about anti-ragging. Principal also pointed out that the college has printed the anti ragging website URL and Toll free number at the backside of each student's id card.

Mr.A.Arul Dhason, Chief Reporter of Tamil Hindu, suggested to add one male representative as the committee member and principal responded that one male student will be added in the committee.

Mr.Britto,Founder of Vaanmugil NGO and Lawyer, appreciated the college management for maintaining the college without any ragging issues and he insisted to conduct awareness programmes regarding dignity and human rights which will enhance the students behavior in a dignified manner.

Mr.K.Kodilingam, Assistant Commissioner of Police, appreciated the college management for maintaining ragging free campus. He also quoted some case studies related to ragging and shared his own experience in dealing with such cases. He suggested the college management to approach him if they encounter any such ragging issues. He also insisted to add student council chairman as one of the student representatives in the committee. Principal responded that it is a very good suggestion and he ensured that the Student Council Chairman will be added in the committee.

Student representative, Miss P.Sherin Mercy suggested to conduct awareness programmes such as street plays regarding ragging offences. Mr.K.Kodilingam responded by suggesting to display ragging offences related matters on the notice board permanently. He also insisted to create some short films by depicting real cases. He advised that, the staff members must have good and healthy rapport with the student's community.

Principal said that the college management is very strict regarding dress code which plays a vital role to avoid ragging. He concluded the meeting by thanking all the members of the committee for their active participation and valuable suggestions.
