FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:

All the students who have studied at St.Xavier's college are members of the alumni association and are encouraged to involve themselves in the programmes conducted by and for them. Occasional meetings of Alumni with the current students are arranged with the purpose of sharing and guidance.

Majority of our alumni (74%) rated the quality of the admission procedure of our institution as excellent, 18% alumni rated it as good, 4% alumni were satisfied. 78% alumni felt that the depth of the course content is excellent, 11% alumni rated it as good and 7% alumni were satisfied.

Most of our alumni (80%) rated the quality of the faculty as excellent, 15% rated it as good. 72% alumni felt that the quality of the teaching learning process as excellent. 2% were unsatisfied with the quality of the teaching learning process.

12% alumni were satisfied with the canteen facilities available in our institution and 19% alumni have given their feedback unsatisfactory. 86% alumni rated the quality of the evaluation methods as excellent, 5% alumni expressed their feedback as satisfactory.


Infrastructure facilities of our institution which includes libraries, LCD projectors, class rooms, laboratory equipments, conference halls, auditorium, hostels, classrooms equipped with smart boards, cleanliness, etc. 79% alumni felt that the infrastructure facilities are excellent in our institution. Only one percent alumni expressed their unsatisfactory with our infrastructure facilities.

71% alumni expressed their feedback on availability of library as excellent. None of our alumni were unsatisfied with the library facility. 57% alumni were expressed that the teacher student relationship is excellent and 5% were satisfied.


89% alumni expressed their overall experience in our campus as excellent, 2% were satisfied.










