The parents of students who have studied at St.Xavier's college are members of the parents association and are encouraged to involve themselves in the overall development of the students. Occasional meetings of parents association is arranged with the purpose of sharing and guidance.

69% parents felt that the quality of the teaching learning process as excellent. 1% of the parents was unsatisfied with the quality of the teaching learning process.


82% parents expressed their feedback on availability of library as excellent. 1% were unsatisfied with the library facility.


54% parents were expressed that the increase in social awareness of their child is excellent and 1% were unsatisfied.


44% parents were expressed that the motivation of the extra curricular activities for their child is excellent and 2% were unsatisfied.


70% parents expressed their overall experience in our campus as excellent, none of the parents was unsatisfied.



















Action taken report
