2.2.1 Dept. of Botany

Botany being a life science subject offers a number of opportunities for experiential and participative learning. While studying about plants in the different semesters, the students are exposed to the different plant specimens in the lab. Moreover, taking sections, dissecting the plants, touching and feeling the different plants and their parts fall within the realm of learning botany. Students also go the field for various field trips. This serves a two-fold purpose – not only do the students see the natural environment in which the plants grow and see the various interrelationships amongst the plants and animals in nature, they are also able to glimpse the unique geography of our country. This ensures not only experiential, but also participative learning for the student is a part of the natural learning environment which he/she is studying.

Problem solving methodologies cover both the academic and non-academic fields. The students are given unknown plant materials which they have to identify using the tools and techniques at their disposal. Further, the students plan, organize and conduct the field tours on their own especially at the PG level. THE RISING STRESS LEVEL

For those who hold extreme jobs, personal life often takes a back seat. Most of the adults work more hours than ever, but one group stands out: those with extreme jobs – people spend more than half their time working and commuting to and from work. Many individuals with extreme jobs see society changing into a "winner takes all" mode, where those who are willing to go the extreme mile will reap a disproportionate share of the intrinsic and extrinsic rewards.

Deepa was spending nearly 13 hours a day working and commuting. She was having an extreme job. Apart from working 60 hours a week, she also had to be available via cell phone 24/7. She had to travel to other countries at least once in two months for duration of two weeks. She was spending more time in commuting. Her son studied in a reputed school and they lived near to the school. She had done everything for her son to be happy but only thing she had to compromise was the time. She never attended the Parent Teacher Meeting in her son's school. Never had she gone to his friend's birthday party with him. Child was left with their maid servant to take care. Morning breakfast was the only time she spends with him. When she returns from office her child would have slept. She felt that her job kept her away from having a good relation with her child.

Though the reason for the rise in extreme jobs is not clear, suspects of globalization, technology and competitiveness are high. Extreme jobs are worse in developing countries where employees work for long and stressful hours. Most surveys indicate that extreme jobs are in a rise in developing countries like India. These jobs are challenging and stimulating but employees find difficulty to adjust work and life in any ways. Though job is interesting to them the stress level in the job is so high that satisfaction level in the job is declining day by day. These become more for women employees in countries like India where child care is considered as a duty of women.

Deepa had informed her employer with the difficulties she faced they couldn't help her beyond a limit. They were pointing at other women employees and commented about her incapability and inefficiency to manage both work and life in a better way.

I. Questions:

1. What do you understand by extreme job? Explain.

The study defined "extreme" as any job that requires more than 60 work hours per week and fits various parameters regarding work flow, travel and responsibilities away from the office and outside commitments.

2. Why do you think there is a rise in extreme jobs?

At a macro level, the reasons behind the rise of the extreme job are structural; it's the outcome of sweeping changes in the global economic environment. These changes—which include increased competitive pressures, vastly improved communication technology, and cultural shifts—intersect in powerful ways.

3. What are the difficulties after undertaking an extreme job?

This case study review the extreme jobs in the context of the institutional, occupational, organizational and individual drivers of long hours and work intensification and identifies the consequences for gender equality, human sustainability and long-term productivity. We suggest that extreme jobs derive not from the 'nature' of managerial and professional work but from working practices and occupational discourses which have developed to suit the gendered norms of 'ideal workers'. These practices and discourses encourage long hours rather than working-hours choices. Extreme jobs extend the gendered division of labour and increase the separation of work and non-work spheres; they are a structure of gender inequality. This review suggests that future research should seek to identify alternative but business-neutral working practices which contest the extreme 'nature' of managerial and professional work, measure the social value of non-work activities and deepen our understanding of the personal and social significance of non-work identities other than motherhood, and disentangle situational motivation, work passion and work holism as motives for devoting long hours to work so that impacts on well-being and productivity can be more clearly understood.

BOTTLED WATER INDUSTRY

The bottled water industry in India is estimated at about Rs 1,000 crore and is growing at 40 per cent. "By 2020, it will reach Rs 4,000 - 5,000 crore with 33 per cent market for natural mineral water. The formal bottled water business in India can be divided broadly into three segments in terms of cost: premium natural mineral water, natural mineral water and packaged drinking water. The per capita consumption of mineral water in India is a mere 0.5-liter compared to 111 liter in

Europe and 45-liter in USA. But over the last ten years, it has witnessed tremendous growth. The change is very much evident. Once a product found mainly at railways stations, mineral water today occupies a place on the shelf in most superstores, grocers and even paan walas. From a mere 60 towns in the year 1997, it is predicted that mineral water is today available in more than 1000 towns and cities across India. With a compounded annual growth rate of close to 30% over the last decade, the mineral water market has witnessed a large growth in terms of volumes.

The market is highly competitive with the entry of MNC's like PepsiCo and Coke. There are a lot of brands available in the market, each with its own proclaimed differentiation. In natural mineral water there are very few companies like Himalayan, Aava, and Evian is playing in the market. 50% of the market is captured by Himalayan.

While a thousand bottled water producers, the Indian bottled water industry is big by even international standards. There are more than 200 brands, nearly 80 per cent of which are local. Most of the small-scale producers sell non-branded products and serve small markets. Despite the large number of small producers, this industry is dominated by the big players - Parle Bisleri, Coca-Cola, PepsiCo, Parle Agro, SKN Breweries and so on.

Consumption of bottled water in India is linked to the level of prosperity in the different regions. The western region accounts for 40 per cent of the market and the eastern region just 10. However, the bottling plants are concentrated in the southern region - of the approximately 1,200 bottling water plants in India, 600 are in Tamil Nadu. This is a major problem because southern India, especially Tamil Nadu, is water starved.

Mineral water business is restricted only to big hotels & Restaurants. This field has lot of scope because of unawareness in the market and people are becoming health conscious. Not just bottlers are involved. In south India, thousands of fuel trucks converted to be water carriers sell ground water to households and establishments at about \$10 for 5,000 liters. More than 13,000 tankers carry water drawn from farmland surrounding Chennai, according a social activist R. Srinivasan. He estimates a

\$148 million tanker industry is cashing in on Chennai's acute water scarcity. The story is replicated across India, including in New Delhi.

II. Questions

- 1. Discuss the reasons behind the growth of bottled water market in India.
 - Increase in per capita spending, rapid urbanization growing, awareness regarding benefits of bottled water and hygiene coupled with increasing preference for active lifestyle is driving India's bottled water market. India is a country with a majority of sunny areas.
- 2. Explain the opportunities and threats to packaged drinking water industry in India.

There are more than 6,000 licensed water bottling setups under BIS (Bureau of Indian Standards) and uncountable unorganised mineral water companies in India. There are around 150 domestic Indian bottled water brands in the market today. The key brands in India are Bisleri, Kinley, Bailey, Aquafina, Himalayan, Rail Neer, Oxyrich, Vedica and Tata Water Plus. Consumption of bottled water in India is linked to the level of prosperity in the different regions. The western region accounts for 40 per cent of the market and the eastern region just 10. However, the bottling plants are concentrated in the southern part of the country. More 55% than of the bottling plants in four southern total are states.

Challenges

The biggest challenge faced by the bottled water companies in India is the duplicacy especially in case of 1 L bottle. It is very easy to create a fake bottled water compared to any other product. Indian consumers tend to believe that any bottled water is safe but this may not be true in case of fake product. Even such type of fake products were produced by filling water in the used pet water bottle and are sold only in few places where public travels most like railway stations, bus stations and metro stations. The other major challenges are from the unorganised sector which is leading in the production of bottled water in rural, semi-urban and few urban areas. As the production does not require big machinery it made counterfeiters to produce bottled water in different regions with single licence and without licence. Quality and safety are the biggest challenges in this unorganised sector. Food safety departments lifted 1,123 samples across the country in 2017-18. Of these, 496 samples failed to meet the quality standards prescribed by the country's apex food regulator FSSAI.

3. Suggest the suitable strategies for these players in the market.

Water bottling companies are booming the market although they received several obstacles from the unorganized sector and availability of one-time investment water purifiers. A huge profit in the market is due to demand raised by the increase in the population and taste of the water. Although several raids are made by BIS and FSSAI but the unorganized sector is rising because of low investment in the production and indiscriminate disposal of used water bottles. So it is the responsibility of the government and every citizen to eradicate unorganized sector and producers not following the required to ensure safe bottled drinking water.

- **2.3.1** Q₁M. Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problems solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences 2022-2023.
 - Learning has been made 'student centric' by encouraging and facilitating 'participatory learning' in Part II as well as Part III classes. For instance, the curriculum in Part II General English is a systematic participatory learning. It trains students chiefly through introducing basic language drills or exercises.
 - The students, on the whole, are encouraged to make proper and extensive use of the library and the internet. Assignments and projects based on the sources are given.
 - The students are made to interact with each other through group discussions and presentations which contribute towards peer-learning.
 - Through a combination of academic and co-curricular activities, the Department encourages advanced learners to optimize their potential.
 - Students are given additional readings related to their subjects.
 - Advanced learners are also offered opportunities to participate in intercollegiate debates, seminars or conferences.
 - The Department promotes interactive teaching-learning through a variety of learnercentered experiences like group discussion, mock interview, brainstorming, progress report presentation, and problem solving.
 - Inspiring critical thinking, creativity and scientific temper are at the core of the teaching-learning process. To this end, various events and activities are organized by the Dept. are the following:
 - Debates / Discussions
 - Seminars / Talks
 - Research based projects
 - Group discussions
 - Audio-visual Presentations
 - Experiential Exercises, Role plays, simulation etc.
 - Case Studies
 - Awareness programmes

- Students are encouraged to think rationally, objectively and creatively. This is nurtured by the participation of students in activities of various students' societies that work under Fine Arts Association.
- Learning has been made 'student centric' by encouraging and facilitating 'participatory learning' in Part II as well as Part III classes. For instance, the curriculum in Part II General English is a systematic participatory learning. It trains.
- Divergent solutions are encouraged in an attempt to nurture openness, creativity, and respect for multiplicity of perspectives. This is invariably achieved by encouraging them to extend their understanding of theories to real-life situations in STAND visits and camps.

2.3.1 Dept. of Folklore

Fieldwork: Apart from regular teaching, we regularly organize field trips to the students to diverse areas, both theme-vise and place -vise. We have organized field trips on various themes of folklore to several areas in Tirunelveli, Tenkasi and Thoothukudi districts. The field trips are also organized based on the themes such as Folk Art and Craft, Popular Religious sites, Tribal and Folk Cultural life, Performing Arts and Museum. Students need to participate in performance arts training such as Paraiyattam, Karagattam, Oyilattam, Devarattam and so on.

Special Lectures: In association with Folklore Resources and Research Centre, SXC, the department organizes invited lectures and special talks on selected themes that will enhance the students' knowledge. As part of Folklore Association, we organize regular lectures that contribute to the teaching learning. Besides, the students are also asked to present short research reports and book reviews. Eminent thinkers, personalities, artists, writers and craftsmen are also invited to interact with students as part of Association activities.

Endowment Lectures: The department also organizes, in association with FRRC, an annual seminar on contemporary themes of Folklore. Moreover, an endowment Lecture for Dr. S.D. Lourdu, Endowment lecture for Rev.Dr.V. Britto S.J. and a memorial lecture for Na. Vanamamalai as Na. Vaa. Day were also organized annually. These lectures and seminars enrich the students' understanding of cultural practices.

2.3.1 Department of Physics

The Department ensures teaching learning is carried out in an efficient and effective manner. The students are encouraged to learn new things from the curriculum and co-curricular activities. In the student-centric approach for teaching, teachers become facilitators for the students. Inviting experts/people of eminence to deliver lectures is also adopted in teaching practices. The students are constantly encouraged to participate in conferences, seminars, workshops organized in and outside the college.

2.3.1 Dept of Social Work

Students of Social Work are provided with an ambiance to have experiential learning through field work practicum in the assigned agencies. Concurrent Field Word is specially designed to provide more direct exposure and opportunities to apply classroom concepts to grassroots level experiences where they organize and undertake individual, group and community focused activities such as counseling, group work and community organization programmes in different agency settings. They undertake 7 days of rural camp activities either in rural or hill stations and 7 days of study tour where they are given adequate exposure to undergo participative learning and at times they use problem solving strategies. Problems solving mechanisms by students are also used while practicing counseling and undertaking group work activities on weekly basis.

2.3.1 – **Dept.** of **Tamil**

Special Lectures - Special guest speakers, usually professors from neighboring colleges whenever possible are invited to deliver a talk on their field of interest. The students get to know the wider scopes in the field of Tamil.

National and international seminars – Interested students are taken/ allowed to participate in conferences, seminars and workshops organized by various colleges within Tamil Nadu. The students are exposed to expertise, and research institutes enabling them to acquire interest to carry out research.

Competitions conducted by neighboring colleges — Interested students are encouraged to participate in inter-collegiate competitions organized by various colleges in and around Tirunelveli District. The students get an opportunity to develop their skills and gain credits in extra-curricular activities.

Seminar classes – Compulsory seminars for all the courses in their degree program.

Discussion – UG and PG Students will discuss about the excavations, objects found in them, inscriptions, Manuscripts, news about Tamil language appearing in newspapers.

2.3.1 Dept. of VISCOM

Student centric methods:

Educational Field Visits

Every year based on the subjects' students are made to visit monuments, temples, historic places, press clubs, public events and universities accompanied by respective staff members who handle the paper. It is important to prepare our students by developing them theoretical knowledge integrating with our curriculum. By the field visit we connect students to the real world and offer them different cultural experience and social bond.

Workshops

Students participating in various workshops can always work on their leadership qualities thereby giving it the proper boost to grow. Skills like Video editing, Audio editing, Painting, Screenplay writing, performing arts, and Human communication can be developed through such platforms which have immense value for students and their upcoming future. Workshops held at regular intervals do perform the same motive for a student. Being exposed to these practices makes him more prone towards learning and getting better with each session. Students attending such workshops can demonstrate their capabilities and can further more update their knowledge through such platforms.

Guest Lectures

Lectures organized within the department for students as a part of the Vis.Com Association. Special guest speakers, usually media professionals from Media industry, professors from media colleges or Universities are invited to deliver a talk on their field of interest. The students get to know the wider scopes and applications in the field of Visual Communication.

Internship

2nd year and 3rd year students actively take part in the internship. Students are given the opportunity to select their area of interest in the media field to do their internship. They Join with various professionals such as TV channels, Radio Channels, Magazines, Daily News Paper, Photography Studio, Audio Studio, Animation Studio, and Graphic Design centers. These internships act as an entry ticket for students who can get them introduced to the already active world of professionalism. They can make the most out of this phase by increasing their contacts and sociable qualities. Students participating in the above arenas on a high priority can be well enough guided to secure their career and make the right endeavors in paving their lives.

Project

Every year all the students undertake individual project and group project work under 4 staff members in the department. They are graded through viva-voce. It enables the students to gain in depth knowledge in their respective media work.

2.3.1 Dept of Zoology

Field Visits and visit to laboratories in research institutes – UG and PG students are made to visit laboratories and research institutes regularly based on the practical course work, accompanied by respective staff members who handle the practical paper.

Group projects for 3^{rd} year UG students –All the final year UG students undertake project work under all the 11 staff members in the department. Each faculty will be allotted 3-5 students who will carry out research in respective discipline and submit dissertation by the end of even semester. A general viva voce will be conducted with external examiner and internal examiner and the marks will be sent to the controller. The student earns 4 credits for this paper. It enables the students to enrich their research knowledge and motivate the students for higher education/research.

Individual project for 2nd year PG students —All the final year PG students undertake individual project work under 11 staff members in the department. Each faculty will be allotted 1 or 2 students who will carry out research in respective discipline and submit dissertation by the end of even semester. A closed viva voce will be conducted with external examiner and internal examiner and the marks will be sent to the controller. The student earns 4 credits for this paper. It enables the students to gain in depth knowledge in research which could inspire and motivate them for research.

Volunteering census and survey of animals in government and non-government agencies – Occasionally students from the Zoology Department are called by the government and non-government agencies for animal census like Tiger, Elephant and Butterfly.

Special Lectures - As a part of the Zoology Association, every year two to seven special lectures are organized for both UG and PG students within the department. Special guest speakers, usually professors from neighbouring colleges and the alumni working in Universities and research institutions in India and abroad whenever possible are invited to deliver a talk on their field of interest. The students get to know the wider scopes and applications in the field of Zoology.

Attending national and international seminars – Interested students are taken/allowed to participate in conferences, seminars and workshops organized by various colleges within TamilNadu. The students are exposed to expertise, scientists and research institutes enabling them to acquire interest to carry out research.

Attending competitions conducted by neighbouring colleges — Interested students are encouraged to participate in inter-collegiate competitions organized by various colleges in and around Tirunelveli District. The students get an opportunity to develop their skills and gain credits in extra-curricular activities. Every year the department has been organizing intercollegiate completion (ZOOFEST) where our students also participate the completions.

Seminar classes – Compulsory seminars using powerpoint by the first and second year PG students for all the courses in their degree program.

Viva voce – Oral examination of individual students for all the core courses in both UG and PG program

Solving puzzles – Crossword puzzles are designed for first year UG students to introduce them to biological terms learnt in their core course.

Chart preparation – Preparation of charts with illustrations of life cycles and different systems in animals, for the UG students

Model-making – Models of biomolecules, fishing nets, breedinghapa, jar hatcheries for PG students

Specimen collection – Collection of molluscan shells, dead insects, bird feathers, aquatic weeds, aquatic insects, freshwater and marine fish, fish egg, fish scales, fossils, endangered species photographs as mini projects.

Newspaper cuttings – Submission of excerpts from news papers on science-related issues (environment protection, climate change, agriculture, pharmacy, research, discovery, invention, etc) and course-related articles for UG and PG.

Dissection – Morphological, anatomical and physiological observation of invertebrates by dissecting for the first year UG students

Slide preparation – Micro slides of planktons, blood cells, stages of cell division, buccal epithelium, developmental stages of chick embryo, insect mouth parts

Analysis – Determination of water quality, enzyme activity, DNA, protein, lipid, carbohydrate, nitrogenous waste products, blood group, haemoglobin, microbial identification, antigenantibody interaction, laws in genetics
