About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) located in the Infocity, Gandhinagar. Major activities and services of the Centre are geared towards modernization of academic libraries and information centres, promotion of information transfer and access, support scholarship, learning and academic pursuits. The Centre acts as a nodal agency for networking of libraries and information centres in universities, institutions of higher learning and R & D institutions in India. The Centre was established as an independent autonomous Inter-University Centre of the UGC in May 1996 and set out to be a major player for promoting scholarly communication among academicians and researchers across the country. With technology being a driving force in the contemporary education system, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken up a number of initiatives for the benefit of the academic community in India.

About St. Xavier's College

St. Xavier's was established at Palayamkottai in 1923 by Jesuit Fathers of the Jesuit Madurai Province with an aim of preparing generations of students for a happy, healthy and harmonious life. The motto of the college is Veritate Lumen et Vita (Light and Life through Truth). It is a grant-in-aid, institution recognized by the UGC Act under sections 2(f) and 12(B). The college is affiliated to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. In recognition of its service and excellence, the college was granted autonomy in 1987. The UGC awarded the status "College with Potential for Excellence" in 2004 and again in 2010, 2014 and 2019. The NAAC accredited at A++ grade with a CGPA of 3.66 out of 4 in IV cycle in 2019. STAR college scheme has been awarded by DBT, Govt. of India. In the ranking conducted by NIRF, the college ranks 55 in College Category in 2023. Today more than 4500 students study in 16 post graduate and 20 under graduate departments. Doctoral research is carried out in 12 departments.
